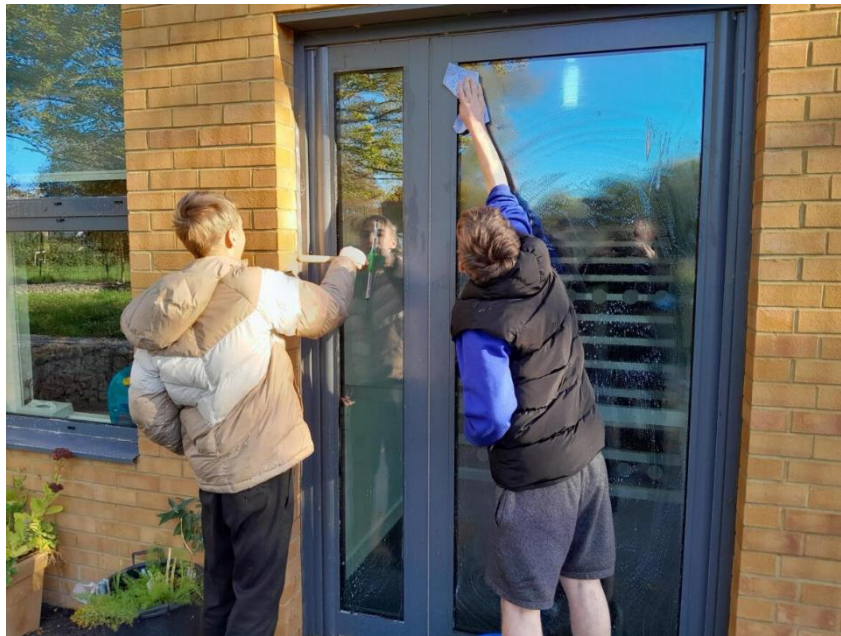


October 2023

Kyle has been working as a gardener learning how to safely use equipment and ensuring the school grounds are tidy and ready for use.



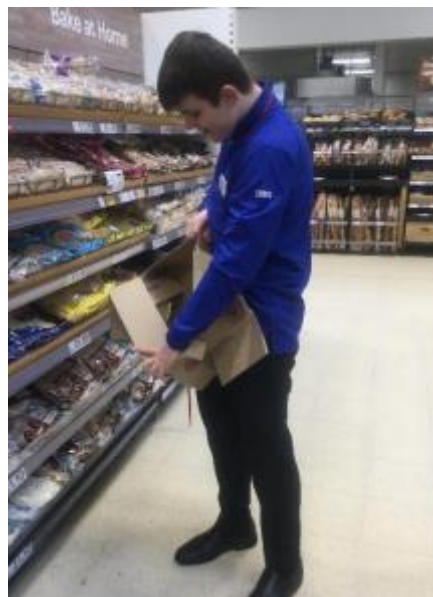
April 2023

Kyle and Charlie have been busy completing the minibus weekly safety checks and monthly clean ensuring the buses are ready for action.

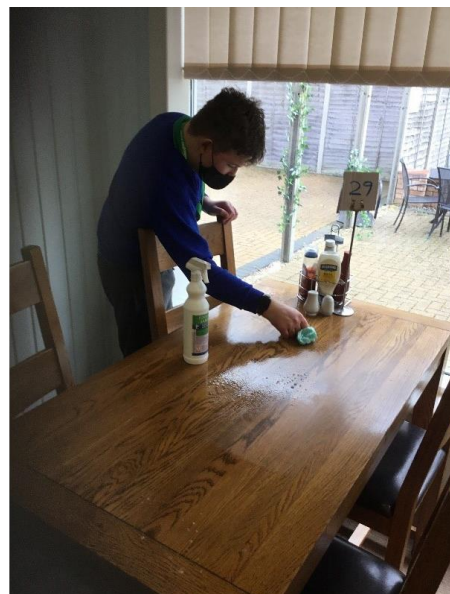
March 2022

Ryan and Jessica attended their interviews at Stringers decorating Centre and have been offered a 12 week placement working as shop assistants.



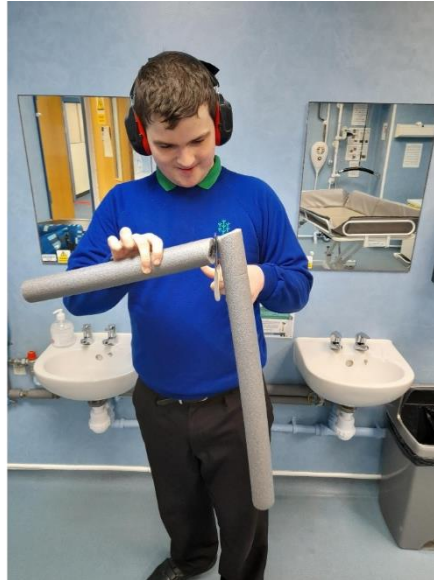
February 2022

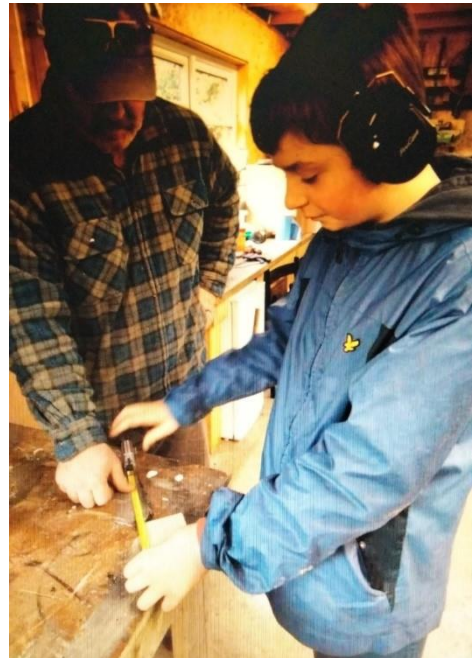

Noah has been working at Don't Lose Hope community garden and shed. Noah has been learning how to use different tools and has made a hedgehog house and bird box for the school grounds.

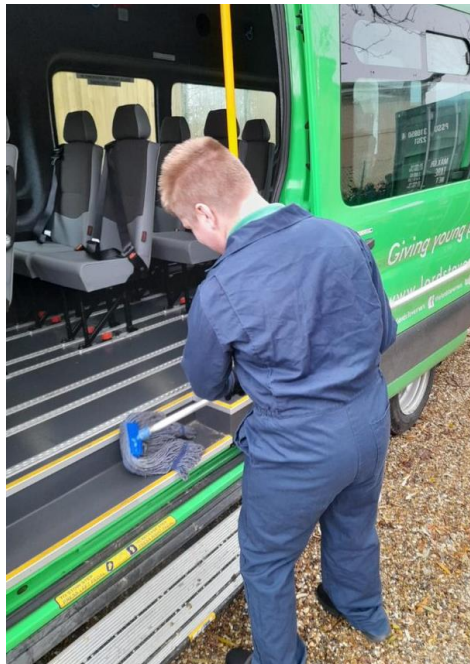
