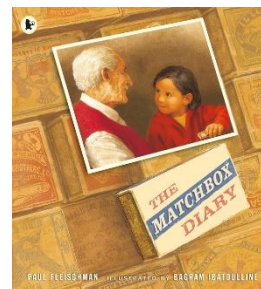

Curriculum

This half term the whole school topic is 'Footsteps through time' and in Snapdragon Class we will be exploring many elements of the past throughout our learning.

In English we will be reading 'The Matchbox Diary'; a story of immigration set in the 1930's. We will also be focussing on our use of the past tense in writing and spoken language. In topic we will be stepping further back and learning about WW1 and what life was like for a variety of people during those times. In Art, we will use printing techniques to recreate and reimagine famous WW1 propaganda posters. In Science, we will take a step even further back with our study of rocks and fossils.

In PSHE we will be learning and online safety and how to use the internet safely. We will also be exploring cyber bullying and how we can deal with it.

We will be following the White Rose Maths curriculum and our focus this half term will be place value.

We will continue our Food & Nutrition lessons with Alison and our Performing Arts lessons with Hilary.
