### Curriculum

This half term pupils will be running a Christmas shop throughout December. The students will create cards, wrapping paper and Christmas tags in their art lessons and sell the items to other pupils and members of staff. The enterprise project will encompass a variety of functional skills such as card writing, monetary transactions, formal communication and much more.

In topic we will look at WW2 through a variety of practical activities, including rationed cooking, building an air raid shelter and holding our very own VE day street party. The pupils will travel through time in our interactive 4D room sessions, stopping off at various points in history. In PHSE we will develop or personal safety awareness when out and about in the community, including stranger danger.

In PE the class will develop their football skills.
