



Curriculum

We will start this term by looking at seasonal changes and focussing on Winter weather, animals, clothes and activities – fingers crossed we do get some snow this term!

We will be using our story to explore what snow and ice feels like and learn about freezing and melting. Our art activities will also link to our story. We will be using symbol cards to create simple sentences.

To develop our social skills, we will be playing lots of games linked to our maths and topic, that will help us learn to take turns.

In maths we will be using our counting skills, exploring 2D shapes, using them to make pictures and using balance scales to compare heavy and light.

In the 4D room we will find out about animals and habitats around the world and will be able to compare hot and cold places.
