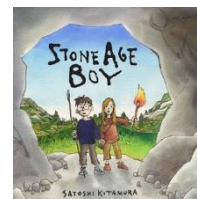

Curriculum

In English this half term, we will be focusing on writing our own narrative. We will be focusing on a range of grammar features, spelling rules and sentence types to write these.

In Maths, we will be continuing to work in our groups. Some pupils will be continuing to develop their knowledge on Addition and Subtraction and later in the term, they will be beginning to learn more about Multiplication and Division. Other pupils will be spending the term focusing on developing Place Value or Multiplication and Division.

For Science this half term, we will be learning about Rocks. We will be investigating different types of rocks and looking at the rock cycle, through the use of chocolate! We will also spend time learning and making our own fossils. This half term, we are lucky to have three whole days of Forest School!
