This year the post 16 classes will follow a mirrored curriculum, meaning that all pupils have the opportunity and flexibility to access challenging and purposeful learning at an appropriate level to them. Curriculum

This term the pupils follow a 'my future theme' looking at personal targets, independence skills and next steps.

This year the classes will be introduced to a new OCR qualification. The qualification has three different entry levels and the units cover a wide variety of independence related learning, allowing pupils to progress through the different levels or move on to a new skill at their own pace. Pupils will complete a bespoke menu of units throughout their time in Post 16.

In PSHE pupils will develop their understanding of emotions, including self regulation and our changing bodies. Each half term the two classes will also collaborate on an enterprise project, in which pupils play a role in creating and selling a product.

Pupils continue to access a weekly food and nutrition lesson and performing arts lesson with subject specialists, along with art and PE. They will explore and learn new life skills in our new independence room fully equipped with a kitchen, lounge, bedroom and soon, a bathroom.
