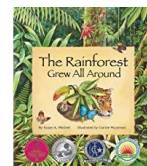

Curriculum

In our communication and language lessons we will be learning about features of information sheets in preparation for creating our own about The Rainforest. We will also be learning about letters, in preparation for writing our own letters to Father Christmas.

We will also be continuing with Read, Write Inc phonics this half term. Children will soon be bringing a 'book bag book home' to continue practising their phonics knowledge. The books will be linked to the sounds they are working on and therefore they will be books the pupils can read independently. In the meantime, a book will be sent home for you to share with your child.

In our cognition and learning sessions, we will be continuing our work on place value of numbers as well as addition and subtraction.
