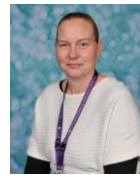

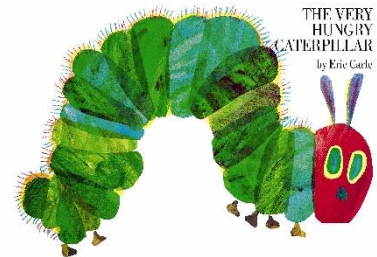

Curriculum

Our school topic this term is 'How Does Your Garden Grow?' and we will be using The Very Hungry Caterpillar as our starting point to learn about planting seeds, fruits and vegetables we can grow and eat and mini-beasts. This will be supported in our 4D room sessions and our Science Week activities.

In our sensory story sessions we will be matching symbols to objects and making simple phrases to describe what is happening in the pictures.

We are starting our maths work with comparing day and night activities - lots of snoring and waking up! We will also be learning about more and less and at snack time, taking turns to hand out plates and food equally.

As part of careers week we will look at what 'jobs' we can do to help in the classroom and around school.

After lunch we will be having turn-taking sessions, with fun toys and a 1 minute timer to help us learn when our turn is finished and to wait for our next go.
