Curriculum

This half term pupils will explore technology ICT and media. Our OCR studies consist of exploring different forms of technology, creating and editing work and researching and producing a presentation on a subject of our pupil's choice. We will also learn about different careers and aspects of our independent living associated with technology.

Our core studies continue to develop our communication, functional literacy and numeracy. In numeracy we begin an OCR unit associated with time. This involves daily routines, recognising different events, different times of the year, reading different times on both analogue and digital clocks and using a calendar. Our theme in PSHE is emotions and self regulation.

Our weekly sessions of food and nutrition, performing arts and the immersive 4D room continue.
