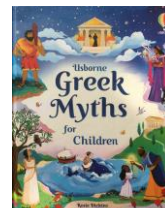

Curriculum

During this term we will be exploring our School topic 'Swords & Sandals' through our class book *Greek Myths*. In our English lessons we will be using this book as inspiration for our vocabulary development, literary comprehension and knowledge of the Ancient World.

In Maths, we will be working hard on our number skills, with a focus on addition, subtraction and multiplication using the White Rose scheme of learning.

In Science, our pupils will be investigating materials and how elements change due to differing conditions such as heat for example.

In PSHE, our focus will be drugs, alcohol and medicines with an emphasis on rules around taking medication and keeping our bodies safe.

Snapdragon pupils will also enjoy Food & Nutrition and Performing Arts with our subject specialists Alison and Hilary.

We will also be thinking about developing our key skills using a scheme called Skills Builder as we look forward to our next steps.
