Curriculum

During this term we will be continuing our School topic 'Swords & Sandals' through our class book *Greek Myths*. In our English lessons we will be using this book as inspiration for our vocabulary and grammatical development, literary comprehension and knowledge of the Ancient World.

In Maths, we will be still focused on our number skills, with an emphasis on addition, subtraction and multiplication using the White Rose scheme of learning.

In Science, we continue with investigation into properties of materials, their changes due to differing conditions whether they are reversible or irreversible, insulators and/or conductors and methods of separating mixtures (evaporation and filtration).

In PSHE, our focus will be on taking care of our environment.

Snapdragon pupils will also enjoy Food & Nutrition and Performing Arts with our subject specialists Alison and Hilary.

We will also be thinking about developing our key skills using a scheme called Skills Builder as we look forward to our next steps in our *Aim Higher* module.
