Curriculum

This term will begin in a very relaxed way, with lots of child-led play, allowing the children to explore their surroundings and build relationships with new staff and children.

Over the term we will use short interactive and sensory activities to build up engagement time and develop familiarity with routines.

Our whole school topic title is 'Know Your Place' and we will use all our subject areas to learn about ourselves, our bodies and our families. The photo albums are already supporting this in our communication sessions, which we will develop into learning signs and symbols for family members and identifying and naming body parts.

In cookery we will develop our fine motor control to mix ingredients and roll and cut out dough, and will be holding a Macmillan coffee afternoon – look out for your invite! Art will also have a fine motor and sensory focus.
