

Curriculum

During our Communication and Language Literacy lessons we'll be reading our story 'In Every House on Every Street'. We'll be working on our fine motor and handwriting skills. We'll also be learning new vocabulary each week, which we will send home weekly via Tapestry. We will be learning about using capital letters and full stops as part of our sentences.

In our Cognition and Learning Numeracy lessons, we'll cover number and place value; addition and subtraction; time and shape.

During Science, we'll be learning about animals including humans; looking at offspring and how animals and humans change overtime.

In PSHE lessons, we'll be answering the big questions, *Who am I?* and *Who are my family?*

As well as these core subjects, we'll be enjoying lessons in Phonics, P.E., Life skills, Forest School and, new for this year, Swimming lessons!
