Curriculum

This new term we have our cross curricular theme 'Know Your Place' through which we shall focus upon knowing the world around us, the community that we live in and also different elements of our own identity. Our class book is the much-loved classic and winner fo the Carnegie Medal '*Tom's Midnight Garden*' which is full of adventure and magic! In our English lessons we will be using this book as inspiration for our key vocabulary and comprehension skills. In Science, our module *Animals including Humans* involves understanding the functions of different parts of the body and the importance of diet and exercise. In PSHE lessons, our focus will reflect the theme of this term as we work on our personal strengths, self-confidence, how we learn and our aspirations. We will also be thinking about developing our key skills using a scheme called Skills Builder as we look forward to our next steps in our *Listening* module.

In Maths, we will be focusing on Number & Place Value, including recognizing hundreds, tens and ones as well as ordering numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in their word format. Just before half term we will be moving on to Telling the Time and starting our times tables and consolidating previous learning of addition/subtraction in our mental maths sessions.

Snapdragon pupils will also enjoy Food & Nutrition and Performing Arts with our subject specialists Alison and Daniella.
