Curriculum

Our theme for this term is 'Know Your Place' which is a lovely topic to begin the year on so we can get to know each other well.

In English we will be exploring fiction books along with story writing. We will be exploring grammar and punctuation such as full stops and capital letters. We will also be continuing our Read Write Inc phonics sounds and reading lessons.

In maths we will be beginning to understand number, place value and addition and subtraction.

Our big question in Science this term is- Who am I? Do living things change or stay the same? We will be exploring this across the curriculum to further our knowledge on animals and humans.

In the classroom we have implemented continuous provision and will be engaging in a mix of adult led and play based learning across the day. Our 'play' will be focused resources and activities linked to the curriculum and our EHCP targets.
