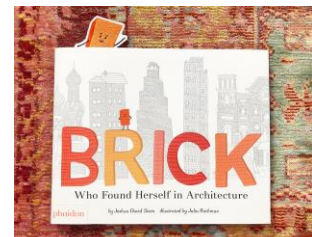

This term our topic is 'Know your place'.
