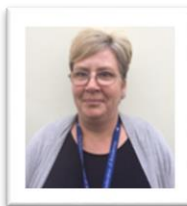

Welcome

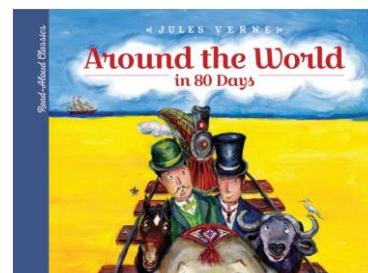
A big hello and welcome back from team Foxglove.
