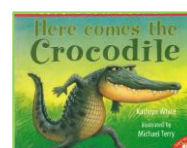

Curriculum

In communication and language we are exploring sensory story before writing sentences about the story. New this term is Attention Autism (Bucket Therapy) and also exploring 4D Room.

This term in Performing Arts we are practising for the Christmas school play.

In cognition and learning we are counting in 1's and 10's, moving onto 2D and 4D shapes and time. In Science we are exploring seasons.

During our PSHE lessons we are looking at Zones of Regulation. We are learning to recognise emotion and use a tool box to self regulate. Linked to this is Emotional Literacy recognising how our bodies feel in different situations. Topics covered will include, Anti-Bullying Week, Remembrance, Diwali and Christmas.

In PE we are learning about turn taking games including, curling and bowling.
