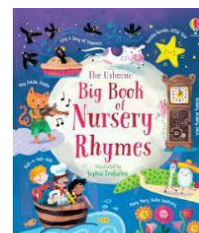

Curriculum

This term we are having a big focus on communication. Every morning we will be working individually or in small groups on speech therapy, IT assisted communication, symbol exchange and signing. We will also be doing short attention & engagement sessions and will start each afternoon with circle time instead of Funky Fingers.

For our 'royal' topic we will be singing nursery rhymes about kings and queens in the 4D room and in our movement to music sessions. Our messy/sensory play will also be linked to the topic.

This term we will start Forest School, please ensure your child has wellies and waterproofs in school. We will explore the paddock, do activities with Dave and sometimes even cook around the fire pit.

In maths we will be building castles, towers and walls (for Humpty to fall off) with bricks and blocks. We will also be learning simple positional language; on, off, up, down, in, out and under through song and play.
