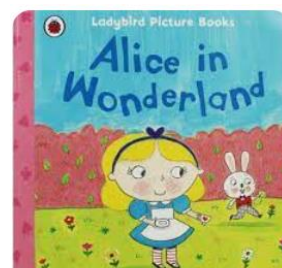

Informal Curriculum
