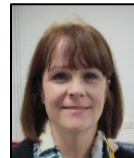

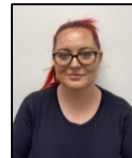

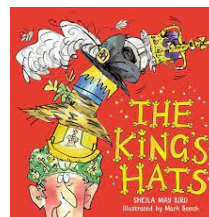


Welcome
