

Curriculum

In our Cognition and Learning lessons we are going to be learning counting to 100 (in 1,2,5,10s), using number lines, partitioning 10, equations and shape.

In Communication and Language our book is 'The Queen's Knickers' but in addition to sentences, we will also be looking at invitations, lists, rhyme and cards. We will also be learning about different careers and writing sentences about those and during the last week of term we will look at the Easter story.

In science we are looking at materials, beginning with naming recycling materials.

In PSHE is all about staying healthy – good hygiene, healthy eating and the importance of exercise.

Emotional Literacy sees us continuing to explore feelings and using our toolbox for support. ICT sees us using technology to draw. Cooking and Performing Arts on Wednesdays followed by Forest School with Dave every Thursday.
