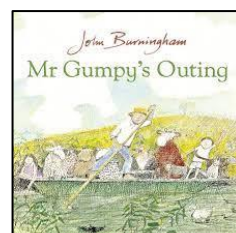

Curriculum

We will be having daily communication sessions that focus on individual speech therapy targets and using symbols and signing to communicate. Linked to our topic work we will be learning farm animal and weather signs.

In maths we will be sorting and counting animals, matching animal toys to pictures and symbols or putting them in the right 'home'.

In our messy play and art afternoons we will be exploring water, rain, wind and rainbows as well as learning a new weather song. Each morning we will sing our song and look out of the window to check what the weather is and find the matching symbol.

Our PE focus will be balance, so we will be using beams and benches as well as trying a little Twister.

Cookery will continue on Wednesday afternoons, this term we will be cutting and tasting exotic fruits.
