Curriculum

This new term we have our cross curricular theme 'Our Amazing World' through which we shall focus upon our class book *The Jungle Book* by Rudyard Kipling. We will be thinking about traditional tales especially from around the world. In Literacy lessons we will be using this book for reference whilst incorporating key vocabulary and comprehension skills. Grammar is still at the core of many lessons and this term we will be casting the spotlight on connectives, compound sentences, compound words, sequencing sentences and prepositions.

In Science, our module *Living Things & Habitats* involves understanding different materials. PE lessons will see us developing our athletics skills and in PSHE we will be working on *Keeping Safe Online* as well as the difference between 'Public' and 'Private'. In computing we will be understanding different processes.

We will also be thinking about developing our key skills using a scheme called Skills Builder as we look forward to our next steps in our *Staying Positive* module and in Math's lessons, our topics cover measures of length, mass and height, directions, measuring time and statistics (reading different charts/data).

Snapdragon pupils will also enjoy Food & Nutrition with subject specialist teacher Alison and Forest School with subject specialist teacher David Hawes.
