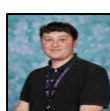

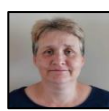

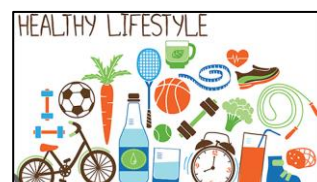

Curriculum
