<u>Curriculum</u>

We start the year with our whole school topic of "Marvellous Me!" and will be using our class story, cookery and the 4D room, to support learning about our body parts and what they can do. There will be lots of peek-a-boo, pretend telephone calls, smelling different scents and body movement songs.

In our adult-led learning times we will be starting 'work boxes', with short, motivating and physical activities such as posting or insert puzzles, to begin to develop focus and the ability to sit at the table to complete tasks. In our maths sessions we are going to learn, match and sort colours, using Pete the Cat and his 4 groovy buttons!

Our class will always have a main focus on communication and social skills so play with adults and peers is a very important aspect of our learning. Adults will be joining children in their chosen play and working on joint attention, back and forth play, simple turn taking and copying actions.
