Curriculum

This term our topic is 'Passport around the World'.

In English we will be reading 'A Ticket around the World'; a non-fiction text that takes us on a worldwide journey. We will be 'visiting' different countries in afternoon Topic lessons, and then we will learn how to write letters in English, about all the places we go!

In Maths, we are continuing our number and place value work that we started in the Autumn term. We will then be developing this by moving onto addition and subtraction. In Science, we will be thinking about where animals live and answering the question 'how do animals adapt to their habitats?'.

In PSHE we are going to be answering the important question, 'Who will I meet in my community (including online)?'. This will include thinking about staying safe online, and managing hurtful behaviour.

We will also continue our lessons in Emotional Literacy, Computing skills, Cooking, Art and Forest School.

This term we are also fortunate enough to have a weekly session on a Friday, with the *Lincolnshire Music Service*.
